Full bottle 1,328 g. Fermentation is finished in second-use barrels and the wine is aged for six months in barrel.

Sandalwood-dusty nose. The oak is too prominent. Vanilla and oak spice obscure the fruit, which, from what I can make out, is good. I can't help thinking they should have stuck to traditional varieties from the region. (TC)
